I want to make you aware that we offer two kinds of age-appropriate developmental screenings at WDS in late September-early October: speech/language screening and occupational screening (assesses motor coordination, sensory process, self-care skills and more). See the attached materials for more details. These screenings take place on our campus and will be scheduled during your child's school day. This is an easy way to gain more information about how you child is developing. These developmental screenings are also a helpful tool to know how to support children in a structured learning environment.

In case you wonder, the children do not feel like they are being singled out for screening. They typically love going to "play games" with the therapists (who are great with young children) and delight in the sticker they get when they are finished.
